## INNOVATIONS & IMPROVEMENTS 2010-2016

- » BreakingGround civic education initiative  
Active involvement in Imagining America consortium advancing civic purpose in humanities, art, and design
- » Creation of new position - Special Assistant to CAHSS Dean for Education and Arts Partnership  
*New partnerships with Walters and Reginald Lewis museums*  
*Growing relationship with Maryland Arts Council*
- » Continued development and marketing of bwtech@UMBC  
Created patent office  
Faculty research commercialization supported by new Technology Catalyst Fund and participation in Maryland Innovation Initiative  
Launched cybersecurity incubator and CYN program at bwtech
- » P-14 Working Group formed in 2013  
Launched partnership with Lakeland Elementary/Middle School
- » Surveyed alumni about satisfaction with UMBC experience and current engagement  
Developed measurable model for alumni engagement in 50th year and beyond
- » Launched Neighbor Relations Group in 2011  
Founding sponsor of Light City Baltimore  
Reallocated resources to fund Baltimore shuttle line



## SELECT ACHIEVEMENTS 2010-2016

- » 130 bwtech companies supporting 1400 jobs in 2016, up from 53 supporting 1198 jobs in 2010  
40 cyber companies at bwtech  
100 student internships supported each semester by bwtech companies
- » 47% increase in alumni annual giving donations, from \$304,308 in FY2010 to \$448,493 in FY2015
- » Awarded \$100,000 to support 37 campus and alumni partners developing 50th anniversary programming
- » Hosted Imagining America national conference in 2015
- » UMBC now home to Maryland Traditions archive
- » Established database of campus partners able to host K-12 visits; pilot K-8 visit day planned
- » More than 600 alumni and friends visited UMBC's Black & Gold Lounge at Light City
- » Large increases in shuttle ridership
- » 34 courses developed or redesigned with BreakingGround grant support
- » 24 community projects developed by UMBC students, faculty, and staff with BreakingGround grant support
